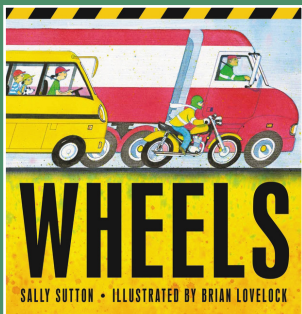

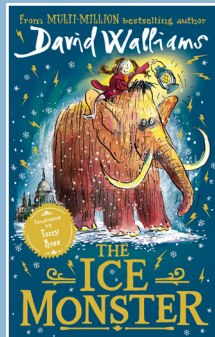
## Wheels
